BONG ZOMBIES NEW COMEDY WEB SERIES ANNOUNCED

Fox on a Hill Productions is proud to announce the completion of BONG ZOMBIES, a new zombie comedy produced in partnership with Chicago's Annoyance Theatre. BONG ZOMBIES is a hilarious original series about two misanthropic millennial stoners, Stash & Ringo, who try to reverse the zombie curse they unwittingly unleashed upon the world. Much to Ringo's chagrin, Stash tries to catch up on reruns of his favorite 1980s TV show, Johnny Patol Private Eye, while they fight to contain a zombie outbreak. As fate would have it, Stash learns to be an unlikely hero from watching Johnny and his companion OTTO, a talking Pontiac Fiero, as they fight the evil Countess Velveta and her minions. The Johnny Patol sequences were filmed using a vintage 3 tube video camera in order to get the look and feel of 1980s television.

BONG ZOMBIES was created by Executive Producer Patrick Schaller and Cinematographer John Terendy. Bong Zombies was written by Eddie Furman. Eddie is a playwright and best selling author and has written sketch comedy for NBC and Second City MainStage. The series was directed by Mick Napier, Founder of The Annoyance Theatre. Mick is an award-winning director, renowned teacher, author of two successful books on improv comedy, and Artistic Consultant for Second City. Cast members who have deep roots in the Chicago theater and improv community include Terrence Carey, George Elrod, Marcel Wilks, Jack Bensinger, Jeff Murdoch, Destini Huston, and Jennifer Estlin.

All five episodes of BONG ZOMBIES were shot at Space Stage Studios and on location in Chicago over a two week shooting schedule. Fox on a Hill maintained a production office with the non-profit incubator Stage 18 Chicago (located at Cinespace Film Studios) during the creation and filming of the show.

This is the latest Fox on a Hill production, following the 2018 TV pilot for *Rogues Gallery* (roguesgallery.xyz). 'Blame it on Toby' stars acclaimed actor Kevin J. O'Connor (*There Will Be Blood - The Mummy*) and screened at top horror venues such as Scremfest in Los Angeles and Music Box of Horrors in Chicago.
